
SWEDEN'S TALLEST BUILDING REACHES NEW HEIGHTS WITH SWEDOOR

Gothenberg sees the arise of the newly established Karlatornet building – designed by worlds leading architects – it is now the tallest building in the Nordics at 245 meters and 73 floors high.

We were proud to deliver over 2,900 Swedoor interior doors and apartment entrance doors within the entire building and the project was one of the largest in Swedoor's history. A wide range of bespoke door options were supplied ranging from traditional white doors to large doors with acoustic seals, hidden hinges, luxurious handles and even custom-made floor-to-ceiling sliding doors.

LUXURY MEETS SAFETY AND DESIGN

The Radisson Blu Aurum Hotel, located in the charming Transylvanian city of Brasov, impresses with exceptionally luxurious design and breathtaking views of the Carpathian Mountains. The stylishly furnished hotel comprises 110 rooms and offers top-class facilities such as a spa area, a fitness center, a business center with meeting rooms and an in-house restaurant.

The luxurious design was also retained when choosing the hotel room doors. For example, Holver Romania installed the DANA DOMINANT 3 model, high-quality security doors with an elegant design. In addition to high fire protection properties, the door model with its 64mm door leaf thickness achieves a sound insulation of 42dB. Hotel guests thus benefit from a higher relaxation factor and can enjoy their privacy thanks to the peace and quiet they gain. In addition, interior doors of the Euroba model with the same surface were installed in various hotel areas.






A BRIGHTER FUTURE FOR ASSISTED CARE SCHEME

SWEDOOR® ON THE BIG SCREEN

Swedoor has delivered 109 interior doors with a focus on sound insulation to a new cinema in Oslo, Norway. Additional sound challenges and unusual sizes required several special adaptations for the doors to meet all requirements. In order to meet the acoustic requirements of the project, the doors to the halls had to be specially manufactured with a sound reduction of 47dB. Gaskets, grouting and general sealing around the doors were also important to make them as soundproof as possible for noise from both the performance and the audience.

In addition, a lot of automation on the doors to the halls was required. They have to be controlled from the projectors in the machine rooms, so that the doors can be opened and closed after each performance. The doors are also connected to the fire alarm system, and several of them have a SALTO card reader function.

All the Swedoor doors that were installed in the cinema have a matt black laminate surface. This makes them easy to clean and resistant to wear and tear.
